Introduction

Bharathiya Vikas Trust founded by Late Sri T A Pai has completed more than 3 ½ decades of useful service to the society. The Trust was registered in 1978 and commenced its activities from May 1981. Sri T A Pai conceived many ideas but did not live to see its implementation. He died on May 29, 1981. These 40 years BVT has experimented with many of his ideas and implemented them on a pilot basis.

Sri T A Pai had supported the concept of Renewable Energy. As a Union Minister, he used his good offices to promote and propagate the use of Bio-Gas as early as in 1973. In pursuance of this, during the last one decade BVT has made efforts to propagate the use of Solar Energy as Renewable Energy all around the country. Today, Solar Energy has become a most important energy solution and the Govt. of India has initiated a National Mission.

Vision:

The main mission of BVT is to bring about tangible change in the rural life by focusing management development in the areas like agriculture, animal husbandry, access to basic energy, education, self-employment, research and development in rural areas


Providing self-employment opportunities for youth towards the utilization of vast human resources to bring about Socio-Eco change in rural areas is the main concern. Harnessing local resources, development of skills, motivation and training to improve the quality of life is provided on a continuous basis to the rural community.

Objectives:

1. To promote education and training to bring about socio-economic change in Rural India.
2. To encourage authors and publishers in furthering the education and training in relation to socio-economic changes in India.
3. To participate in rural development programs in India as prescribed by the Government of India under Section 35CC of the Income Tax Act 1961 as are found to be charitable and not involving / carrying on of any activity for profit
4. To grant lump sum grants or recurring grants in furtherance of the above objects.
5. The Trust shall mainly engage in to carry out and/or associate itself solely or in association with other groups/groups for carrying out rural development programs as approved by the prescribed authorities under the Income Tax Act.
6. To take up scientific research and rural development and application of science and technology in dairy, poultry, horticulture, sericulture and apiculture, grass and fodder cultivation, breeding of milking animals and cottage / mini / small scale / medium scale industries, any suitable energy resources, water conservation and technology, fisheries, service industries.

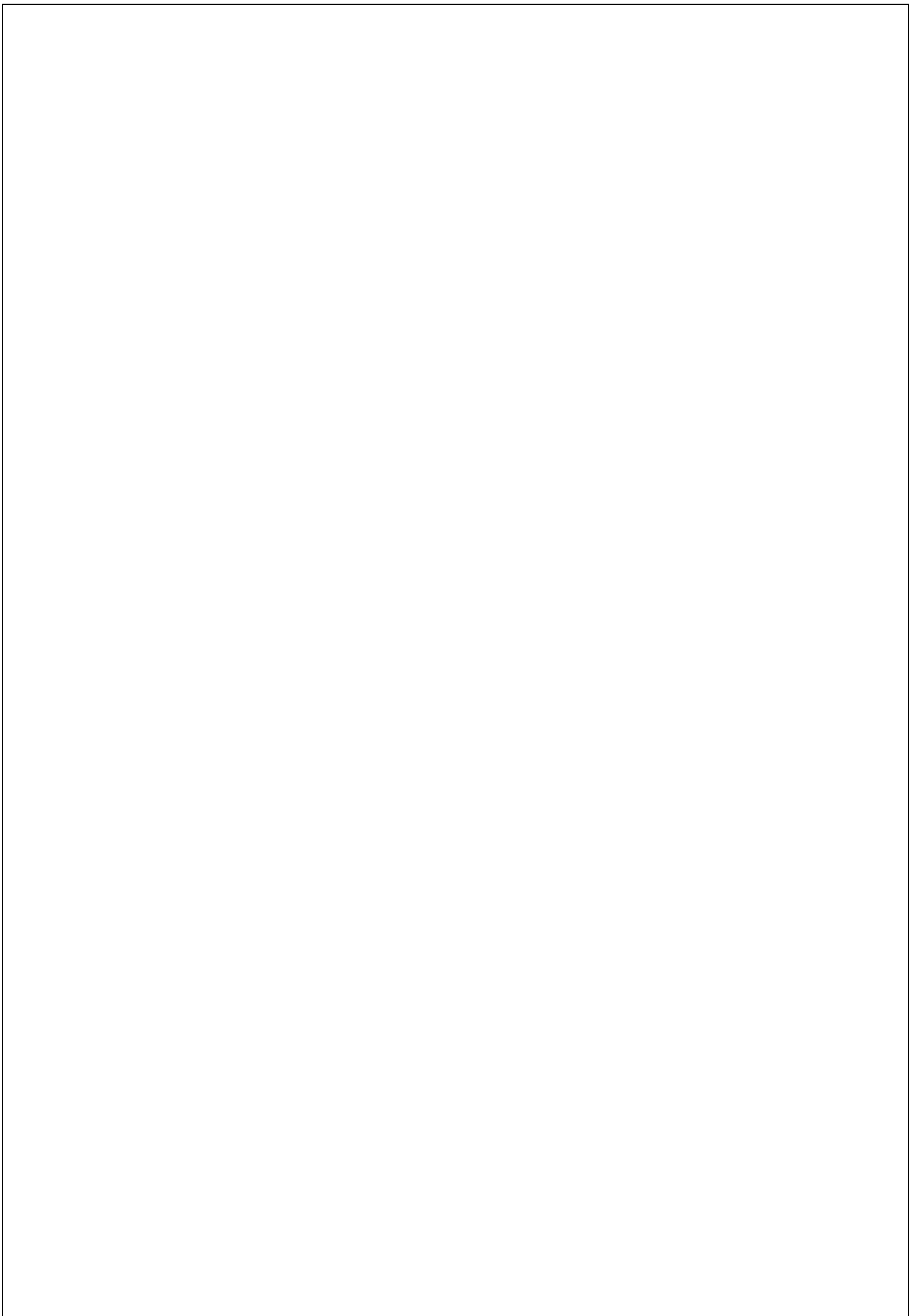

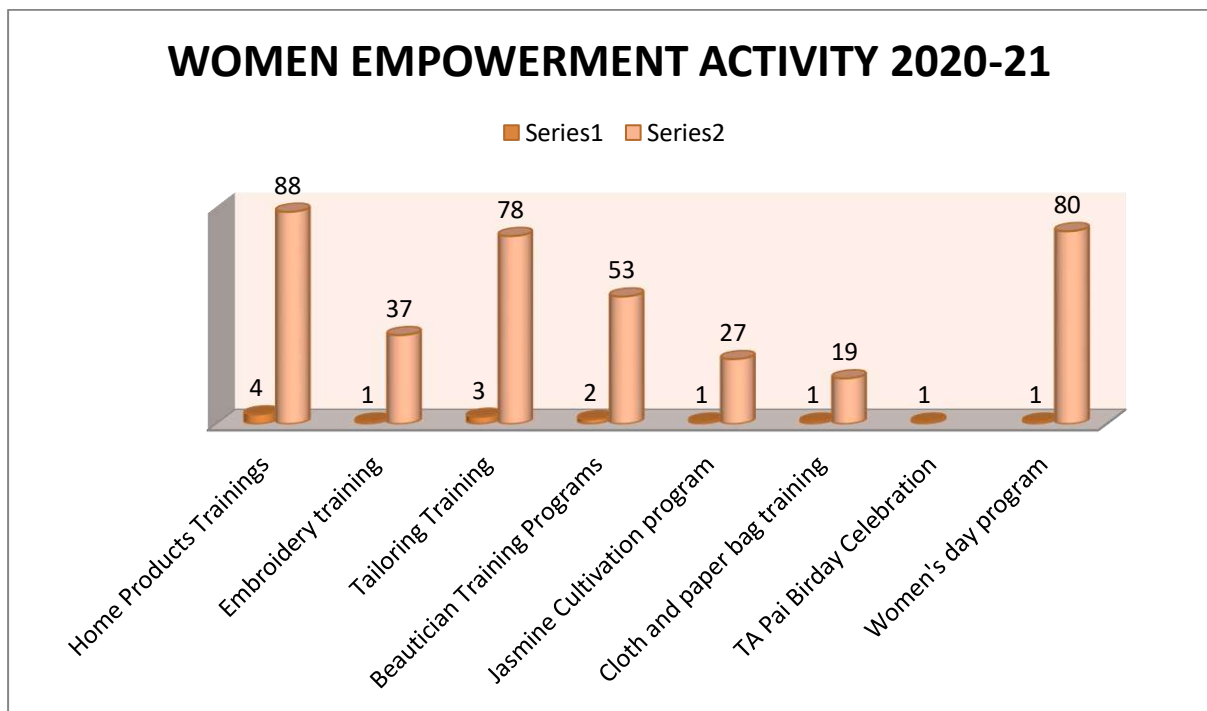

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Empower the women with education, social, economic opportunities and health care. And making the women too powerful to make them capable of deciding for themselves and improve their decision making skills.

Various skill development workshops are being conducted for rural women to become self-sufficient. It is also conducting training to run the home industries.



BVT under women empowerment vertical organised 14 programs and covered 382 people of Udupi, Dakshina Kannada, Uttar Kannada and Gulbarga Districts.

Home products training



BVT has given training on food products. Participants were given training on various making of sambar, rasam, Kashaya and puliogare powders like selection of spices/ingredients (coriander seeds, cumin seeds, mustard seeds, chilly) processing like frying, grinding were also thought.

- To process of making pickles from mango, lemons were also demonstrated.
- Preparation of 7 cups sweets, papad and other fried items (Sandige) were also thought.
- Home Consumable products- Under this participants were given training on preparation of handmade soap, phenol, etc

A techniques were how to prepare on Home utility products like Zip pouch, cloth bag, coconut coir mat, were given. And the focus was to make the women to prepare these items mainly for selling at their homes/exhibitions/ village weekly market, etc. Entrepreneurship tips were also given to the participants during the training.

This year BVT organised 4 training programs on home products at Udupi and Dakshina Kannada Districts. Total 88 women have got benefitted from the training program. 26 women beneficiaries are doing self-employment and earning income from it.

Embroidery Training

BVT has given training on Embroidery. Participants were given training on hand embroidery, machine embroidery pot painting, fabric painting, artificial flower making, etc.

This year BVT organised the



embroidery training at BVT campus and 37 women were benefitted from the training program. 14 women are doing self-employment and 13 are in first stage (threshold stage) and one woman is in second stage and earning good income out of it.

Tailoring Training:



Livelihood training programs conducted for women to develop their skills and involve them in income generating activities.

This year BVT organised 3 tailoring training programs at Udupi and Kalburgi Districts. Total 78 women were benefitted from the training program. 62 women are doing self-employment training and 60 women are in first stage (threshold stage) and two women are in second stage, earning income out of it.

For this batch organised entrepreneurship development program and additional 5 days training total 27 participants got benefitted from the training.

Beautician Training:

This year BVT organised 2 beautician training program at Udupi and Uttar Kannada Districts. Total 53 women were got benefitted from the training. 21 women are doing self-employment, 18 women are in first stage, 2 women are in second stage and one women in 3rd stage and earning income out of it.



Jasmine Cultivation Training:



BVT organised one Jasmine Cultivation training program at Bidkalkatte, Udupi District. Total 27 women were participated.

Cloth and Paper bag training:

BVT organised cloth and paper bag training at Udupi district and total 19 women were benefitted from the training.



TA Pai Birthday Celebration:

On the birthday (January 17th) of Sri. T.A Pai (Founder of BVT) there has been a practice of giving lunch to following institutes namely Asha Nilaya Lombard Memorial Hospital Udupi, T.A Pai Modern Higher Primary School Kadabettu, Shri Krishna BalaNiketana Kukkikatte. But due to pandemic all students are in houses so Asha Nilaya requested BVT to provide grow bags for vegetable garden/kitchen garden. BVT provided financial support to Asha Nilaya and they have purchased 20 grow bags.

They have grown many vegetables and used for schools and remaining they sell to shops and earned income out of it.



International Women's day program

This year BVT organised the International Women's Day program at BVT Campus. The program was inaugurated by the Smt. Bhuvaneshwari Hegade, Writer, Siddapura. Total 80 women have participated in the program. Program had 3 sessions on women and governance, women and law, women and health the sessions are taken by followingly by Smt. Veena Vivekananda, CDPO, Women and Child Welfare Department, Udupi Districts, Smt. Kaveri, Senior Civil Judge and Member of the District Legal Service Authority, Udupi and Dr. Nagarathna, THO (Taluk Health Officer), Udupi.

GOOD GOVERNANCE

KAVALAMUDOOR VILLAGE and Other Villages of D.K

Ensuring people participation in local governance and making a model village in all aspects. Good Governance project implemented in Kavalmadoor Gramapanchayath at Bantwal Taluk, D.K district. In this village BVT implemented a model village concept which will be model for other GP. In this project BVT focuses on waste management, women and youth empowerment and organic farming.



Under Good Governance vertical BVT organised 30 programs and covered 1402 people of Mangaluru, Puttur, Bantwala and Udupi Districts.

Elders committee meeting:-



At Keddalike village BVT formed an Elders committee which is a committee of Local leaders which will help BVT to Plan, implement and monitor the project at community level. This committee will help sustain the project with local participation. ZP members, Panchayat

members, SDMC members, local farmers, School HM, SHG federation members, ASHA worker, Anganawadi worker and other local CBO representatives are members of this committee.

During corona time also this committee took in charge of conducting activities at Keddalike village. With the help of elders committee conducted many programs to farmers, women, youth and other general community people.

Awareness program on Government schemes



BVT organized awareness program on different government schemes like Atal pension scheme, jeevanjyoti insurance scheme, Pradhanmanthrishrama yogi scheme, MGNREGA scheme, SukanyaSamruddhiyojana, KisanSamman scheme, RastriyaPoustikAbhiyan, Ayushman Bharat health scheme etc. In this program resource persons from government and NGO gave information about scheme and how to apply to scheme.

We conducted 4 awareness programs where 140 people participated and nearly 23 people got these schemes after awareness programs.

NABARD sponsored Financial Literacy Program at Village.



BVT Organized Awareness programs on financial literacy program, Digital banking, and Different loan facility available at bank and insurance schemes available at bank. This awareness programs sponsored by NABARD and organized at different villages of Dakshina Kannada and Udupi districts. This helped village people to know about banking facility available for women and general community.

Total 5 programs conducted and nearly 183 people participated in this program. Nearly 21 women applied for insurance facility available at bank after this program.

NABARD sponsored Training program to NGO representatives and SHG members about banking facility.

BVT organized training programme to different NGO representatives of D.K and Udupi districts and also training program to SHG representatives of D.K. This training sponsored by NABARD where subjects covered in training are banking facility available for SHG groups and how banking sector will help SHG to get loan for self-employment in village level.

BVT organized 2 trainings at D.K total 76 people participated in this financial inclusion training.



Celebration of World Rural women day and World soil day.

BVT organized world rural women day and World Soil day programs at Villages of Dakshina Kannada. This program organized with collaboration of KVK Mangalore. Resource persons gave information of importance of rural women in agriculture and importance of soil test in agriculture. During this program KVK and BVT felicitated farmers for their contribution in agriculture.

BVT organized 2 programs and 70 farmers participated in this program. Farmers got benefited from this program and came forward to do soil test of their agriculture land after training.



CANARA Bank sponsored Skill Training Program to Women

To start any self-employment skill is essential, so that BVT organized skill training on artificial jewellery making, cloth bag making and masala powder making to SHG members. This training conducted at Mangalore and Puttur Taluk which is sponsored by Canara Bank of respective branches.

2 skill training organized and 58 women participated in this training. After the training women showed interest to take loan from Canara bank and wanted to start self-employment at village.



Camp on Ayushman Bharath health card registration camp.



BVT Manipal, SKDRDP Keddalike and Gramapanchayath Kavalmaoor jointly organized 1 day camp on Ayushman Bharath Health card registration and distribution. Ayushman Bharath Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana is a scheme of India Government to provide free access to healthcare. These Yojana beneficiaries get an e card that can be used to avail services to an empanelled hospital, public or private anywhere in the country. The coverage includes 3 days of pre- hospitalisation and 15 days of post hospitalisation expenses. This e card provides coverage of Rs.5 lakh per family, per year.

Nearly 342 community people got benefited for this camp and this is good example for good governance where people getting government facility in their doorsteps.

Training to farmers about integrated agriculture components.

BVT Manipal organized Trainings on Integrated agriculture components with collaboration of KrishiVijnan Kendra Mangalore. Farmers of Kavalmaoor village need to implement different types of Integrated components like vegetable garden, animal husbandry, horticulture crops, mushroom cultivation, inland fishery, Poultry etc. in their agriculture farm which will give them monthly income each time. So that BVT conducted trainings like vegetable crop management, vermin compost preparation training, inland fish agriculture and mushroom cultivation etc. in each month.

Average 30 farmers each month participated and some farmers implementing some components in their farm which help BVT to develop Kavalmadoor as a model village.



Training to Youth

BVT organized one day training on Mushroom cultivation to youth. Mushrooms have high demand in villages and urban places for its nutrition and medicinal contents. Youth can start this business with limited space and there is good market facility also available for mushroom. 54 youth participated in this training and nearly 12 youth have a plan to start mushroom cultivation in their village which will help them to earn income and also employment in village level.



I.G.P training to women.

BVT conducted Income Generator program training to women which will help them to start their own self-employment at their will with SHG federation members. Also they can avail Bank loan or Government schemes to start self-employment after attending training.

BVT conducted training on cloth bag making, Paper bag making and Sambhar powder making training which has good demand in market and women can start this business with minimum investment. Conducted 2 trainings at Kavalmadoor village and 71 women benefited from the training.



Survey of farmers for Nutri Garden Project Initiated by KVK.

ICAR and KrishiVigyan Kendra Mangalore implementing project on Nutri garden. This is mainly on home nutri garden and health conditions of farmer's family. KVK developed questionnaire according to this subject and wanted to survey of Keddalike farmers who grow vegetables.

KVK approached BVT for Household survey of 25 farmers. With collaboration of KVK Mangalore, BVT and Keddalike elder committee conducted household survey of 25 farmers in the month of July. Seeds will be distributed in the month of October and BVT will monitor this project in future.



Vermicomposting, Wall painting and Incinerator:-

BVT developed some model units at Keddalike village which will be model to other villages. Constructed Vermin compost tank which will helpful to farmers, get organic manure with available materials. Constructed Incinerator which will burn sanitary napkins, medical waste and used face mask, which is pollution free and less expensive. Painted COVID-19 awareness information and waste management information at wall which is informative and people will understand information very easily.



Children Grama Sabha and Training to GP members on model village.

BVT organized Children Gramasabha at Kavalamadoor Panchyath with collaboration of Panchayth. This program helped Children to share their problem with Panchayth members. Children also got information about children rights, Schemes available for children and how children make their village as a model village. BVT also conducted one day training to Kavalamdoor panchayth members on model village concept. Panchyath members prepared next 1 year action plan for making their village model in waste management, organic farming and women empowerment concepts.

BVT organized 2 programs and 80 people got benefit of this training.



Immunization camp to children.

BVT organized immunization camp to below 5 years of children at Keddalike Anganawadi of Kavalmadoor Village. This camp organized with the collaboration of Punjalakte PHC. Keddalike village children got immunization vaccination at their places which saved their time and money.

BVT organized 1 camp and 24 children below 5 got benefited of this free camp.



Livelihood training to Youth.

BVT organized 6 days livelihood coconut tree climbing training to Youth with collaboration of KVK Mangalore. In this training youth got practical training on coconut tree climbing from experts. Youth also got information about Government facility to start their self-employment, information of bank loans, marketing skills, communication skills and leadership skills in this training.

20 youth participated in this training and got free coconut tree climbing machine, which help them to start self-employment in future and help them earn Rs.15,000 to Rs.20,000 per month.

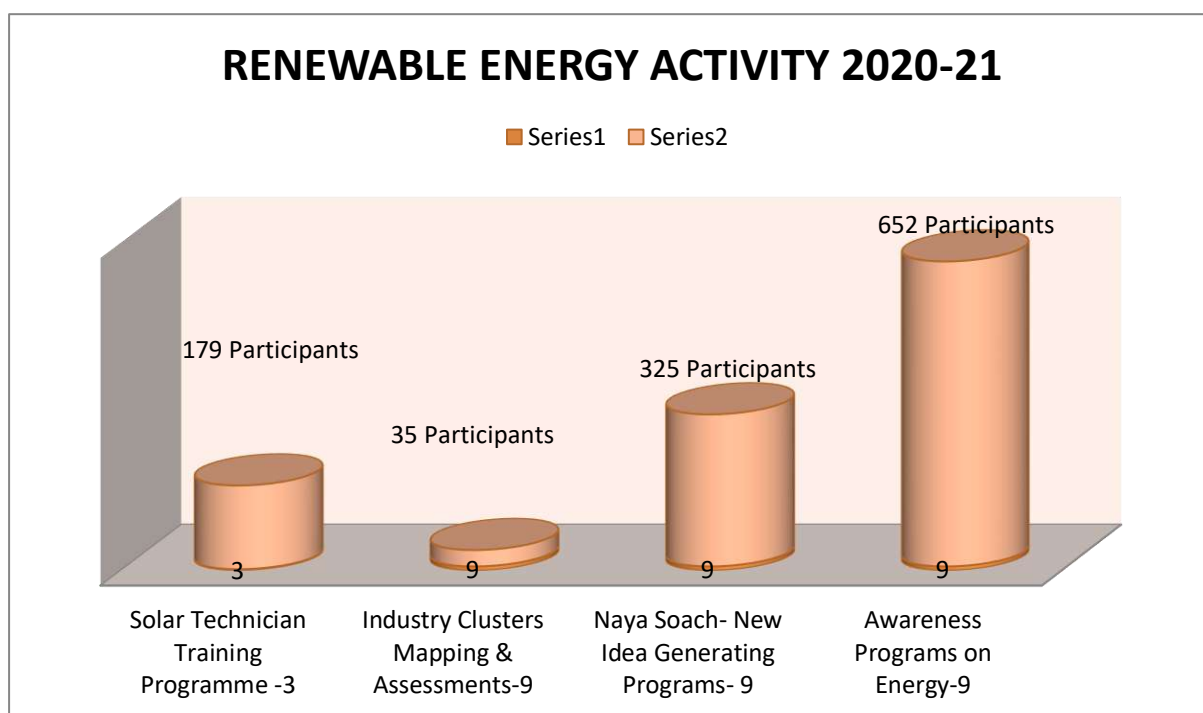

Efforts towards developing rural livelihood avenues and an ecosystem for delivering sustainable energy. Training and building capacity of technical institutions. Training of solar technicians cum service entrepreneurs in repair and maintenance of solar solutions.



Under Renewable Energy and FIS vertical BVT organised 30 programs and covered 1191 people of Bagalkota, Uttarkannada, Udupi, DK, Districts.

Solar technician training program

There are many examples where the technology has been widely adopted due to the fact that an agency/organization was there to deliver the product and service thereby transforming the markets for solar PV technology in those areas. However, the need of the hour is to create many more grass root level technicians / entrepreneurs who can transform themselves into a business cum service entrepreneurs to take up the RE technologies/solar business in a sustainable manner. In order to enhance the propagation of Solar energy and impetus to the post installation services of solar energy systems, BVT is making efforts to train Service entrepreneurs/ Technicians in the solar sector as part of its effort of developing an ecosystem for delivering sustainable energy solutions. At the same time the effort will also create significant livelihood opportunities in the sector in rural areas of the State. Under this, BVT - A NLT recognized by MNRE, in association & Sponsorship of Mahatma Gandhi Institute for Rural Energy & Development (MGIRED), Dept of RD&PR, Govt. of Karnataka is organizing Solar Technician Training programs for the last 5 years. Looking at the encouraging response and impact, the training effort was continued for the year 2020-21 and

organized 8 technician training programs at various ITIs (Industrial Training Institutes) .Duration of the program is 3 days which includes theoretical and practical sessions. Presentations and talks will be provided by subject experts and also resource persons. Practical sessions are carried out with demonstration of solar panel installation, water heater installation. Certificate is provided to each participant after finishing the program.

Totally this year 179 ITI students are benefited from this program.



Rural Industry Cluster Assessment & Mapping

BVT has come up with some innovative program of supporting & training rural home industries which are struggling to scale up themselves or finding difficulties marketing linkages. We have identified some of Bamboo & Pottery products making industries udupidistrict conducted mapping study by visiting the industries found that they need further support such as training to scale up their productivity, training on new products, marketing linkages, linkage with sustainable energy solutions. Places like Karkala, Aloor Kundpura, Bramhavara has got bamboo and pottery industries selling some basic utensils made of pottery, bamboo products like bamboo roofing, bamboo caps, and decorative products.



Naya Soch - Idea Generating Program.

As we know that the demands of human beings increasing day by day & to fulfil that there is requirement of energy. Currently due to decreasing quantity of non-renewable energy like petroleum, fossil fuels is increasing need and demand for sustainable energy solutions like solar. Solar lighting systems & Water heaters are already there but that is not enough so there is need to increase the application of solar energy in all technological aspects. Aim of this program is to explore new possibilities and ideas related to sustainable energy by conducting workshops to various students of technical institutes identifying best ideas and developing it further as a model or prototype. If prototype works then it can be developed as actual product.

Totally of 652 SHG members participated in these programs.

COVID EFFORTS

Background:

As the world know that since January 2020, SARS-CoV-2, the corona virus out of China's Hubei province has swiftly spread to 76 countries worldwide, infected large number of people across the world. The WHO has also declared its spread a 'public health emergency of international concern'. Today, COVID-19, the disease caused by the corona virus, is present literally everywhere across world.

The Government of India confirmed that India's first case of Corona virus disease 2019 on 30 January 2020 and looking to its severity and spread ,on 24 March, the Government of India ordered a nationwide lockdown for 21 days, limiting movement of the entire 1.3 billion population of India as a preventive measure against the 2020 corona virus pandemic in India.

Social distancing is the only way to break the cycle of infection and fight against COVID means – *Stay home stay safe* was approach instructed strictly by Govt and lockdown was imposed from April 2020 onwards.

During this lock down period, BVT, realising its Commitment to society and need for involvement / contribution towards Combating against COVID, BVT planned some useful programs / efforts by exploring its strength, past experiences and network developed. As per the action plan /strategies, BVT has made significant need based efforts and contributed through its various activities to reach number of needy and vulnerable community across the State during COVID period . Preparing and distribution of Cotton – Impermeable Aprons to 154 GPs of Udupi dist.

Looking to the encouraging responses and impact of Mask effort, Zilla Panchayath, Udupi has appreciated the effort and requested us to associate in their program of distribution of PPE kits. Under this, ZP has requested to take up a program on preparation of Apron- Cotton impermeable for health and SLRM workers of selected SLRM Gram Panchayath.

Based on the initial discussions with ZP and SLRM-SBM depts., CEO, ZP requested BVT to prepare about 500 cotton impermeable Aprons for health and SLRM workers of GPs. A sample was shown and after discussions with ZP and Dist health dept officials, a model was finalised.

As cotton with plastic inside – impermeable Apron on 60: 40 BVT) cost sharing basis and Gap funding.

AFFORDABLE – FORDABLE SWAP COLLECTION KIOSKS

Continued efforts on developing Affordable – fordable Swap collection Kiosks with solar interventions.

Based on the highly encouraging responses, appreciation and request for similar kiosks from Health dept and ZP and other concerned depts./ agencies of various districts, the effort was scaled up and more than 100 such kiosks were developed. These kiosks will be delivered/ installed at PHCs of most of the districts of Karnataka.

To begin with, 15 kiosks for Udupi district were inaugurated/ handed over officially by Sri G Jagadeesha., DC, Udupi



Similarly at Chikamagalur, 5 Kiosk are installed at PHCs and Sri C.T Ravi, Minister Tourism, Govt of Karnataka inaugurated the Kiosks at Chikmagalur and appreciated and thanked BVT and SELCO for their active involvement and support .

At Bidar, CEO, ZP appreciated and thanked BVT and SELCO for their support. DHO inaugurated and Kiosks and extended thanks to.



The best part of the kiosk is that it is cost effective, affordable, fordable and developed within a short duration by taking all necessary precautions, safety measures of collection of swab in more systematic manner. The Kiosk is well equipped with uninterrupted power through Solar interventions to run fans, light, mobile charging and small head light for screening. This will create healthy working conditions to health workers who carry out the test and enhance the efficiency of testing work in a given time. The Kiosk also has a provision for storing the samples in small refrigeration boxes.

COVID-19 Model Fever Clinic cum Swab Collection Kiosk

Looking to the need and challenges of testing facilities of ILI and SARI suspects/affected persons and corresponding request received from health dept of Udupi , BVT in association with SELCO has develop a tailor-made affordable Fever Clinics cum swap collection Kiosks model under the guidance of Health dept at health centres Utilizing existing infrastructure / facilities and other resources

Looking to the need for establishing more number of fever clinics and based on the request received from Health dept., Kundapura, a Fever Clinic Cum Kiosk is established at Primary Health Centre, Basrur, Kundapura Tq, Udupi.

The outer portion of the room – Window of 8 'X 4 Ft was modified and converted into a testing and swap collection Kiosk using the same structure of our Kiosk model.

Necessary fabrication and modification of the Window structure is done as per design to carry out the functions of Clinics hassle free.

The collection place was completely covered with Chamber which is made up of GI strong structure frame and PVC- Board flex (star) materials for 3 sides of walls keeping one side open for entry. Screen printed of IEF awareness matter of COVID.



The Window and surrounding wall are completely sealed with silicon plastering stripes and foam plastering to make it completely air tightened. To carry out the collection and or testing in a convenient manner and more clarity, an acrylic sheet is fixed at the front wall/ side with an opening fitted with surgical gloves for easy to test the swap from the suspected person.



The person being tested is asked stand outside the testing window in the closed Chamber comfortably with the help of holding rest bars fixed to the chamber and a health workers/ technician will be seated inside the room /window will test / collect swap through the front through which two rubber gloves are attached. The health worker will insert a hand in the rubber gloves and collect swab samples and blood samples from the patients through a testing stick.

The front side is completely air tight inside and outside and highly protected by the COVID. All necessary IEC mater of COVID is printed.

A power operated Sanitizer sprayer is fixed at the Chamber to sanities the chamber after testing / collection regularly.

A Separate entry and exit is provided to the testing area to take care of necessary guidelines, safety and precautions.

The best part of the Clinic is that it is well equipped with uninterrupted power through solar interventions to run fans, 2 lights, mobile charging and small head light for screening. This will create healthy working conditions to health workers who carry out the test and enhance the efficiency of testing work in a given time. We are also exploring the power intervention for storing the samples in small refrigeration container/ boxes which ensures temp of 4 °C for transport to nearest testing centre.

The Unit is prepared under the guidance of Taluk Health officer and PHC doctor and very useful for collection of swap at rural areas / PHCs where it is easy to install and uninstall after the work and the swap.

The utility also supports Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for booth workers (healthcare staff). Surgical Gloves and a medical kit to collect samples are placed inside the booth for the healthcare worker. The testing Clinic/kiosk eradicates the need for at-risk persons to visit the nearest hospital or clinic and helps in effective implementation of social distancing norms during collection and testing of samples.

Covid 19 awareness programs

BVT organised the awareness programs at Gulbarga Districts with the collaboration of Mrs. Supriya Joshi, SRJ Abacus institute, Gulbarga. Conducted 7 programs and 392 people are participated in the program. They distributed the awareness posters, stickers and masks during the program

BVT organized awareness program on COVID-19 to SHG members, SDMC members, farmers and other general community people. BVT organized programs by following all government guidelines and during program distributed mask and demonstrated correct method of hand wash. Also explained about Corona virus, symptoms, precautions and treatment procedures.

We conducted nearly 06 awareness programs and 210 people got awareness directly. BVT also distributed awareness posters to shops, government offices and other departments. Also distributed stickers about face mask and distributed to bus and auto with collaboration of RTO Mangalore.
